What do these pictures have In common?

These photos represent some of the 47 organizations and \$1.6 million that AAWGT has invested in our community since 2007 to help improve the lives of women and families in Anne Arundel County!



Is your organization eligible?

- ✓ Your organization must be a 501(c)(3) and registered with the federal government.
- ✓ Your organization must be current with the Maryland Secretary of State which means you will have a Charity Number.
- ✓ Your organization must be in good standing with the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation.
- ✓ Your proposal must help improve the quality of life for women and families in Anne Arundel County.
- ✓ Have you been funded by AAWGT in the past? Organizations who receive grants for two
 consecutive years will not be eligible to apply for the following two years.

1. Know your <u>three</u> numbers!

The following instructions appear on the Application and in the Application Guidance:



Federal Employee Identification Number (EIN)

This number identifies your organization as a non-profit.

Your EIN will look like this: 00-0000000

Website to verify: https://apps.irs.gov/app/eos/

Maryland Charity Registration number (CID)

This number identifies the organization with the Maryland Secretary of State.

Your MD Charity number will look like this: 00000 or this: 0000

Website to verify: https://onestop.md.gov/list_views/62f3e1797f7e3200016a3dab

It must state: Organization must be listed as 'Registration Status: Current'

Business Entity Number with the Maryland Department of Taxation and Assessments.

Your Business Entity number will look like this: InitialLetter00000000

Website to verify: https://egov.maryland.gov/BusinessExpress/EntitySearch

Organization must be listed as 'This business is in good standing'




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

- 2. Our focus continues to be on "improving the quality of life for women and families" -- but we have widened the lens of what that might include.
- 3. We have increased the maximum amount you may request to \$25,000 (minimum stays at \$5,000) we recognize that the cost of doing business has gone up for everyone!
- 4. The Application....
 - Is available to read and submit in English or Spanish;
 - Has fewer, more targeted questions, focused on what you want us to know!
 - Deadline for submission is Friday, February 10, 2023 at 11:59PM;
 - Must be submitted online through our grant software Foundant




Some Basics About Using Foundant

- ✓ All grant applications must be submitted using our grantmaking software, Foundant.
- ✓ Each organization may only have one online account, submit one application and receive one grant.
- ✓ We strongly recommend that you use **Google Chrome** web browser to access our online application. Do not use Internet Explorer.
- ✓ Before you start, decide who will be the software **Primary Contact** for your organization. (If you so desire, you may add additional Contacts (users) who are designated to either view, edit, and/or submit the application using the Collaboration function.)

Step One: Signing into Foundant

- ✓ To sign in, go to www.givingtogether.org/grants -- click on **GRANTS.....**
 - Choose GRANTS PORTAL;
 - Then LOG ON HERE TO GRANTS PORTAL.
 - You are now at the Logon Page.

From here you will create an account if you are new ... or sign in if you already have an account.



- ✓ If your organization has already an account, **do not create a new account.** Each organization may have only one account; the software tracks users by EIN and will not allow multiple accounts.
 - Don't know if you already have an account, or you need the account transferred to a new email address? Email <u>GrantAppHelp@givingtogether.org</u>.
- ✓ **New organization?** Click on **Create New Account** and enter the requested information.

A few hints while working on your Application...

- ✓ **Saving your work:** the software will intermittently save your work. However, there can be a time delay so we recommend periodically use the **Save Application** button at the bottom of the page to ensure your work is saved. If there is no activity for 40 minutes, the software will save your work and log you off. You may return later and continue editing your application.
- ✓ Calculating Character Count: each answer field has a maximum character limit. Note that spaces and punctuation also count as characters. Please use only 1 space between sentences.
- ✓ Application questions marked with an * are questions to which a response is required; they must be answered in order for your application to be electronically submitted.
- ✓ When your application is complete, click Submit Application. Once you press "Submit", no additions or changes to your application will be possible.



What We **Don't** Fund:

- Organizations that discriminate by race, creed, gender, sexual orientation, age, religion, disability or national origin
- Capital projects, including new construction, expansion, renovation or replacement of existing buildings
- Endowments
- Sponsorships or fundraising drives/events
- Banquets, receptions or similar events
- Political activities or lobbying
- Sectarian religious activities
- Grants to individuals

January 4, 2023: Call for Applications released and grant application available online.

January 12, 2023: Zoom Grant Applicant Workshop.

February 10, 2023: Applications are due at 11:59 pm

May 2023: AAWGT Members vote on grant proposals

and winners are contacted


July 1, 2023: Grant year funding begins
